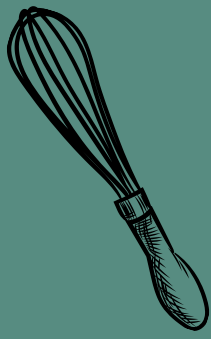

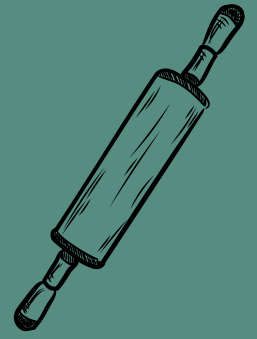

### **March Birthstone: Aquamarine**

With colors ranging from light blue to dark blue and even blue-green, aquamarine has been linked to water and the seas throughout history. Roman fishermen called the gemstone “water of the sea” and used it as protection, for safe travel by boat, and for luck in catching fish. Aquamarine was linked to the apostle St. Thomas who frequently traveled by boat.

Roman physicians also used it to treat overeating and bloating.

These flowers are a symbol of spring and new beginnings, and their bright yellow color represents positivity and joy. They can also symbolize strength and resilience, as they grow strong in challenging conditions.
